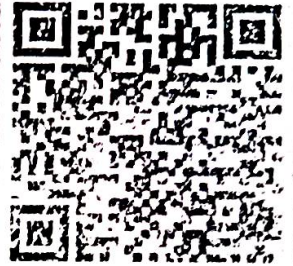

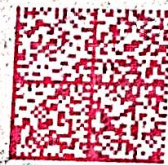

## Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Patliputra University, Patna

and

The Climate Agenda

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is entered into on the \_\_\_ day of November month in the year 2025 between:

**Patliputra University, Patna** (hereinafter referred to as "University"), a State University established by the order of the Government of Bihar, vide Letter/memo no. 15/M1-71/2016-700, dated 09.04.2018, which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, mean the Vice-Chancellor, Patliputra University and include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the "First Party"

AND

**The Climate Agenda, Patna** (hereinafter referred to as "Organization"), a not-for-profit organization registered under The Indian Trust Act, 1882, having its Head office at 11, Adarsh Nagar, Mahmoorganj, Varanasi, Pin 221010, duly represented by the Director of the Organization and include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the "Second Party".

### PURPOSE of This MoU:

The purpose of this MoU is to set forth the terms and conditions under which Patliputra University and The Climate Agenda will collaborate to provide internship opportunities for students and to promote joint awareness programs, seminars, conferences, workshops, and guest lectures on various **climate change-related themes** including but not limited to **climate science, sustainable development, public health, urban mobility, renewable energy, livelihood resilience, and environmental justice**. This partnership aims to empower students, increase their practical exposure, and contribute to the academic, environmental, and social development of the community.

### OBJECTIVE OF THE MOU

Both Parties agree to collaborate on the following activities:

#### a. Internship Opportunities

Students from various departments of the University and its affiliated colleges will apply through the University website to participate in internships organised by **The Climate Agenda**. The Climate Agenda will offer internships to university students, providing **hands-on exposure to climate action projects, research, and community-based sustainability initiatives / solutions**.

The Climate Agenda will ensure that internship duration meets the 60-hour criteria (approximately 4 **academic credits**) as per the National Education Policy (NEP).

The Organisation will ensure mentorship and guidance during the internship period and will issue certificates with a grading system (A to F) upon successful completion of the internship, where (A is for excellent work, B is good, C is satisfactory, D is a passing but less than satisfactory grade, and F is for failing the course).

#### **b. Awareness Programs**

Both Parties will jointly organise awareness programs, seminars, workshops, and discussions on relevant **climate and sustainability-related topics**, including clean air, waste management, sustainable transport, renewable energy, climate-health intersections, and community adaptation.

These programs can be held at Patliputra University as well as its affiliated colleges in their seminar halls or other suitable venues notified by the University.

The University will facilitate the venue for such programs and encourage student participation.

Such programs can also be organized outside campus as the proposed programs may need.

#### **c. Guest Lectures**

The Climate Agenda will arrange guest lectures on topics related to **climate science, policy, environmental governance, green economy, sustainable mobility, and public health impacts of pollution and climate change.**

The University will promote and organise these lectures in coordination with relevant departments and encourage student engagement.

#### **GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION**

This MOU, its meaning and interpretation, and the relation between the parties shall be governed by the laws applicable in India, and they only shall have exclusive jurisdiction at Patna over matters relating to or arising from this MOU.

#### **LANGUAGE**

This MOU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters relating to the meaning or interpretation of this MOU.

#### **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

All intellectual property, including but not limited to research outputs, survey data, study reports, publications, training materials, campaign content, designs, methodologies, or any other work produced by the interns during the course of their engagement under this Internship Program, shall be the sole and exclusive property of The Climate Agenda. The University and the participating interns agree that no rights, title, or interest in any such intellectual property shall vest in them. Any use, reproduction, or dissemination of such materials shall require prior written consent from The Climate Agenda.

#### **LOCATION**

The internship program arising under this MOU shall be performed by the Second Party from its office at Patna and/or its nearest regional office or in collaboration with various government, academic, and non-government stakeholders in Bihar.

#### **AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVES**

Any action required or permitted to be taken and any document required or permitted to be executed under this MOU may be taken or executed:

On behalf of the **First Party**, by the Vice-Chancellor, Patliputra University, or their designated representative.

On behalf of the **Second Party**, by the Director of Programs, The Climate Agenda, or their designated representative.

#### **COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MOU**

This MOU shall come into force from the date of signing, or such other date as may be mutually agreed upon by the two parties.

Modification of the terms and conditions of this MOU, including any change in the programme as agreed, may only be made by prior written agreement between the parties.

The University introduced this program to enhance the environmental and sustainability-related learning outcomes of its students.

The Climate Agenda will be implementing this programme for a period of **three years** from the date of signing this MoU, which might be extended or renewed for another similar period, based on mutual agreement.

The Climate Agenda also reserves the right to terminate the MoU under any of the following conditions:

- Lack of coordination and support from the University.
- Force Majeure conditions.

#### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

##### **a. Responsibilities of the University (First Party)**

- The University will encourage students from various departments of its affiliated colleges who are willing to participate in internships.
- The University will promote awareness programs, seminars, and guest lectures through its official communication channels.
- The University/affiliated college shall allow the organisation to communicate with the students both virtually and on campus about the Programmes and Activities.
- The University/affiliated college shall permit the organisation to communicate with students through signboards, e-posters, banners, or awareness events organised periodically in consultation with the University/affiliated college.
- The University/affiliated college shall nominate a single point of contact to facilitate and troubleshoot the Programme at the University/affiliate college and ensure half-yearly meetings with the Vice-Chancellor to review progress.
- The University/affiliate college shall ensure full support and cooperation to the organization's staff in all aspects to ensure effective delivery of the program.
- The University will provide seminar halls or other suitable spaces for organizing programs and events in collaboration with The Climate Agenda.

#### **b. Responsibilities of the Organization (Second Party)**

- The Climate Agenda will organise, manage, and supervise internship programs for students of the University and its affiliated Colleges.
- During internships, which may include field exposure, outside campus activities, surveys, or community engagement, students may be asked to bear partial costs of travel or accommodation based on activity requirements.
- The Climate Agenda will provide necessary resources, speakers, and facilitators to conduct awareness programs, seminars, workshops, and guest lectures.
- The Climate Agenda shall abide by all the rules and regulations of the University/affiliate college in its functioning.
- The Climate Agenda shall furnish relevant information, progress reports, and impact evaluation reports corresponding to student participation as required by the University.
- The Climate Agenda will ensure that students receive proper guidance, mentorship, and feedback during their internships.

#### **DIGITAL PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION ACT**

Both parties will ensure compliance with the **Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023**. Any data or information related to staff, students, or individuals involved in the activities under this agreement will be kept confidential.

Students participating in internships will be prohibited from using or sharing any sensitive or confidential data gathered during their fieldwork or research. They will be strictly instructed not to infringe upon privacy or share any information outside the scope of their internship tasks.

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#### **ARBITRATION**

Both parties shall endeavour to resolve or settle disputes through mutual negotiation and discussion. Any disputes arising out of or relating to this MOU that cannot be amicably resolved shall be referred for arbitration to a suitable committee at the University. The arbitral award shall be final and binding on both parties.

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To carry out and fulfil the aims of this agreement, each party will appoint an appropriate person(s) to represent its organisation and coordinate the implementation of activities.




